Dear Red Dust Revival 2022 Motorcycle Entrant,

Phew! The time has finally arrived where we can open our event to formal entries. Thanks to everyone who has been patient and waiting expectantly for the entry forms. To everyone who has completed an "Expression of Interest" form, it is now time to formalise your entry by completing the attached entry form. Note that this is the motorcycle entry only. If you have put in an Expression of Interest for your car then you'll get a separate email.

By entering the Lake Perkolilli Red Dust Revival 2022 you automatically become a member of the most exclusive club in world motor sport – a member of the Lake Perkolilli Motor Sport Club Inc!

Thanks to our sponsors and a lot of effort by our volunteers, we've managed to keep your entry fee to about the same price as 2019. The Lake Perkolilli Motor Sport Club Inc. is operating the event under the rules of AASA and Motorcycling Australia.

You are receiving this email as you have either participated in the previous Red Dust Revival, or have lodged an expression of interest to compete in the event this year.

Entry is now open and is done in the same way as before, via online. Click onto:

The total cost should come to \$239.34. If you already have a Motorcycling WA competitors licence you should be able to select the option of having a licence already. This should reduce the fee by \$70. The price of entry includes a program and camping fees for the week (for the competitor only).

If you have any issues trying to enrol and things are not happening as they should, please give me a call.

We always need more flaggies. These need not be qualified as training will be provided. All volunteers and officials will receive a pack only available to those that work the event.

For 2022, the charity Variety is handling the camping and visitor entry and there is a charge. This money goes to the children's charity and we are very pleased that needy children benefit from us having fun. You will be able to pay your entrant camping fee and secure your space with your entry. In the coming months, we'll have information on how your friends and family can pre-pay for camping and entry.

We have already sold out of car badges and we're ordering more. Note that you don't receive a free badge with your entry. We have decided to go ahead with the Commemorative Book produced after the event. You can pre-order this book by paying the fee up-front. Please contact Graeme Cocks by email for details. This will help us cover the costs before it is printed and will ensure that you obtain a copy. We can't guarantee that you will be able to secure a copy after it is printed if you haven't pre-ordered.

Due to the nature of the event we have to apply a criteria to decide who we accept. Please contact me if you have any eligibility questions.

The official program was a winner at previous events. Have your story featured by putting some info together and sending in some pics.

If you're planning to enter multiple vehicles (a mix of cars and motorcycles) then please contact me and I'll discuss the cost of your entry.

Scrutineering of motorcycles will take place at Perkolilli and perhaps at a Perth location before the event.

We are hoping to make the Red Dust Revival 2022 just as relaxed and just as much fun as previous events. The response was amazing last time so we've tried to get ahead of the game this time around. You can help us by getting your entries in as soon as possible.

Closing date for entries is 30 April 2022. Photographs and stories can be sent to Graeme Cocks.

None of us can predict the future. If for some reason we are not able to run the event, then appropriate refunds will be provided.

This may sound complicated but we've tried to keep it as simple as possible while covering everything we need and putting it all into one email. If you have any queries, our contact details are on the form.

How to take a great Bike pic for Perko



We'll be putting the Red Dust Revival Event Program together earlier this year so it isn't a rush so close to the big event.

We'd like every entrant's bike in the program if possible — and with a great pic and a story. Here's what we're chasing.

The best pics are the ones taken either side-on or from the front quarter of the bike. The bike should be big enough to fill the screen but not too big that we can't see the whole car. Shoot in high resolution so that the file is about 3mb or more. This means that if the pic is fantastic we can blow it up to a full page if we need to. Pics taken from the back or square at the front aren't so good as we can't see your bike. Pics are better with people in them. Stand with your bike and be proud! Take a look at these pics (left) taken by Sharon Smith at the last event.

Some other basic dos and don'ts:

- * Don't shoot into the sun. Have the sun behind you.
- * Don't shoot half in the sun and half in the shade.
- * Do shoot with a nice background. Retro would be great.
- * This is a fun event. Smile for the camera!

The Event Program from the last event has become quite collectible so it's worth putting in some effort on your pics. If your bike is not yet ready, some construction pics would be great. We have a separate page attached with a quiz so we can write about you and your bike. Please fill it out.
